ARKANSAS DENTISTS RECEIVE NEA ATTACHMENT PROGRAM

National Electronic Attachment, Inc. (NEA) announced today that all dental providers submitting electronic claims in the state of Arkansas have received a copy of the NEA electronic attachment software.
